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Public Notice of Title VI Program Rights

The Arizona Department of Public Safety gives public notice that it is the Agency's policy to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), and other related authorities in all programs and activities.

The Arizona Department of Public Safety's Title VI Program requires that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, age, sex, disability, low income status or limited English proficiency (LEP) be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity.

The Arizona Department of Public Safety will have posters and pamphlets placed in publically accessed facilities as well as publishing this Notice to the Public on its website.

Any person who believes his/her Title VI or ADA rights have been violated, may file a complaint. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed within one hundred eighty (180) days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence to:
