SCHOOL BUS ACCIDENT / INCIDENT REPORT

In accordance with R13-13-104 E.2, Immediately upon receiving notification of any accident involving a school bus, the employer shall notify the Department of the accident by telephone (602) 223-2646. The employer shall submit written verification of the accident to the Department within 72 hours of the telephone notification. In accordance with R13-13-104 E.3, Immediately upon becoming aware of a violation of these rules or state statutes that a reasonable person could conclude caused injury to or threatened the health, safety or welfare of a passenger, the employer shall notify the Department of the violation by telephone. The employer shall submit a written report of the violation to the Department within 72 hours of the telephone notification. Submit Accident/Incident forms by email, fax or postal mail.
