

# **Requirements for 925 Vehicles**



#### **925 Vehicle Requirements**

- SB 1630 and ARS 15-925
- Does **not** require a CDL
- 11-15 Passenger (to include driver)
- Type A School Bus
- 8-way overhead flashing lights and a stop arm.
- Must be painted school bus yellow by June 30, 2027.

#### **925 Driver Requirements**

- Medical Cert
- 5 & 9 Panel Drug Screens
- 20 hours of Behind the Wheel
- 14 hours of classroom
- CPR & First Aid
- PPT
- Level one IVP clearance Card
- 39-Month MVR
