

**Safety and Storage Regulations**

To ensure the safety of our students and the cleanliness of our fleet, please adhere to the following updated guidelines:

**Brooms**

Brooms of any kind are strictly prohibited on a school bus.

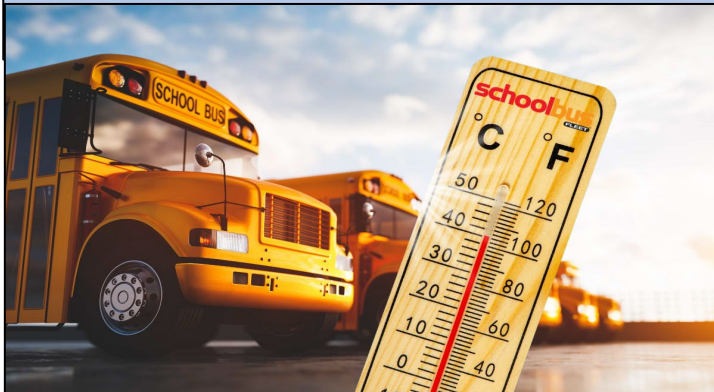
**Cleaning supplies**

All cleaning supplies must be stored securely and always kept away from children. (Please note if your bus doesn't have a designated storage compartments, all cleaning supplies must be left at the bus yard)

**Q'Straints and Aisle Safety**

Q'Straints must be pushed flat against the wall when not in use.

*(Never leave straps in the outer aisle. This creates a serious tripping hazard for students and staff.)*

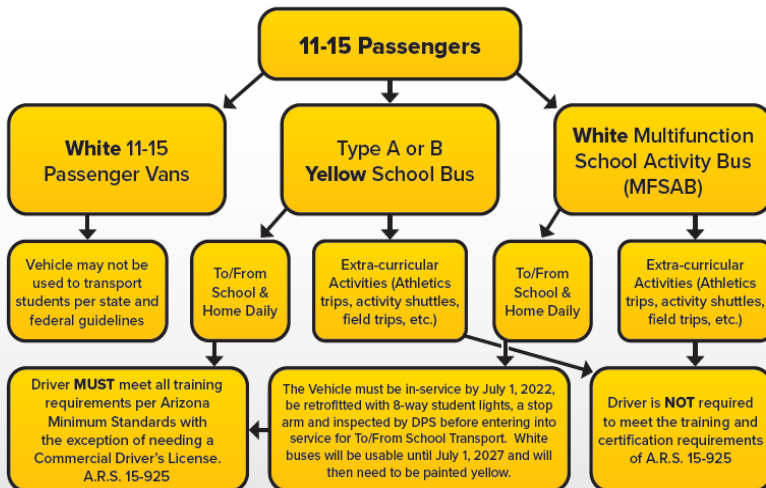
Magnetic items on a school bus are **NOT APPROVED**. This includes Tissue Box, Clips, Cup Holders etc.



## Important Regulatory Update: New Article 3 Enforcement

Effective immediately, Article 3 is being enforced for all 15-925 drivers and vehicles. This new section introduces updated safety and certification standards for 11 to 15 passenger school buses.
