The guiding principles of the Arizona Sex Offender Management Board (AZSOMB) include respecting the rights, interests, and the impact of sexual offenses on victims; protecting the safety of the community; and providing evidence-based evaluation and treatment of sex offenders. Arizona law allows a trial court and a defendant to request a psycho-sexual evaluation prior to sentencing. It is the position of AZSOMB that voluntary pre-sentencing evaluations should be utilized in all appropriate cases.

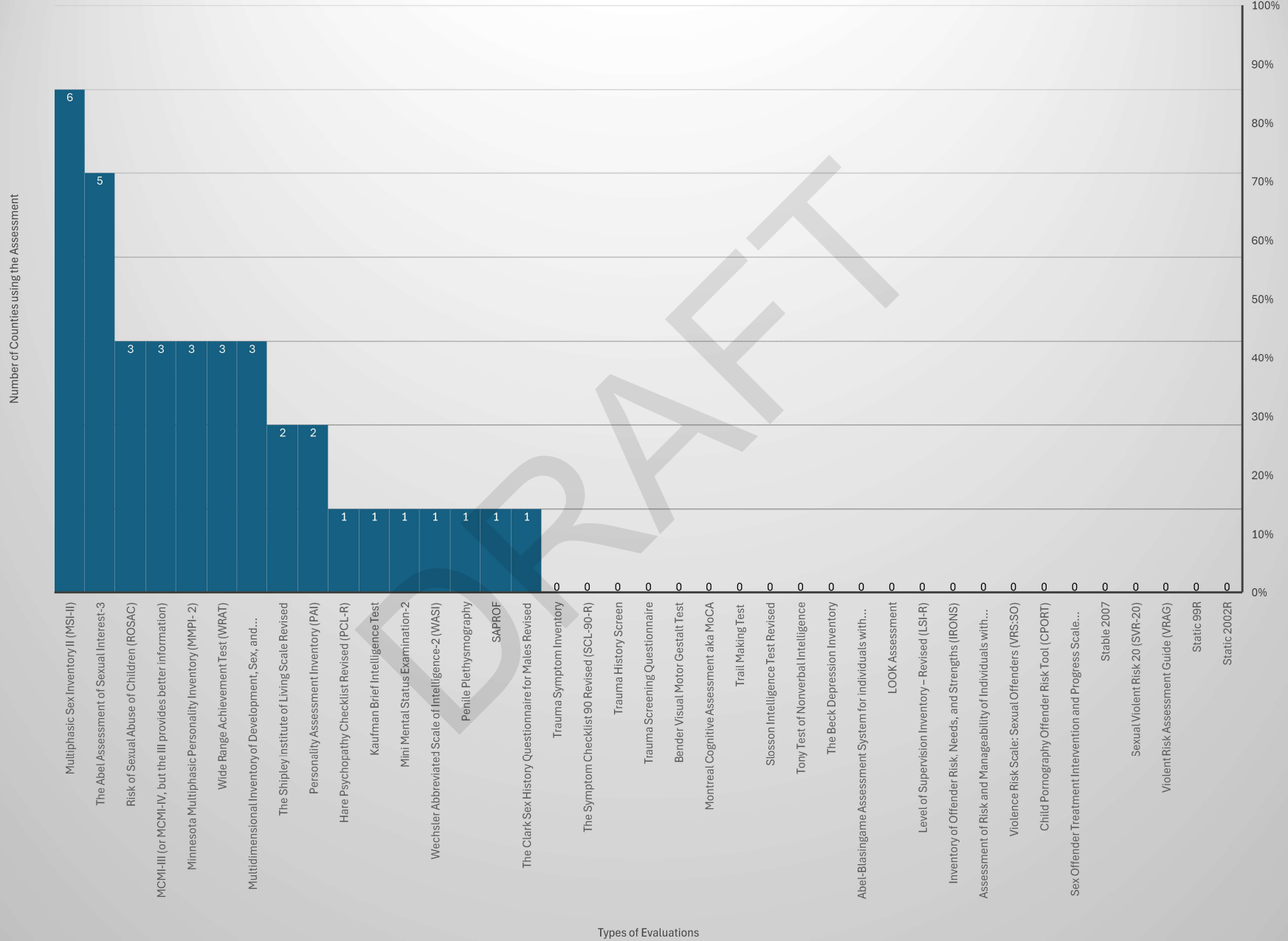
