THE QUALIFYING PARTY, ASSOCIATE(S), OR EMPLOYEE(S) ARE NOT PEACE OFFICERS OR RESERVE PEACE OFFICERS.

**Per A.R.S. § 32-2414 Peace officers and reserve peace officers are prohibited from applying.

Documents to be enclosed:



1. AGENCY APPLICATION
Complete all sections of the application. The application must be signed and dated.
2. AGENCY APPLICATION FEE \$250.00
Money order, Cashier's check, Agency's business check, or cash.
3. AGENCY STRUCTURE PAPERS AND/OR TRADE NAME
Corporation papers, partnership agreements, foreign corporation papers, etc. Submit trade name documents if doing business under a different name.
4. QUALIFYING PARTY EXPERIENCE DOCUMENTS
Per A.R.S. § 32-2422, Documents must show a minimum of three years of verifiable full-time, hands-on investigative experience.
5. PHOTOCOPY OF DRIVER'S LICENSE, PASSPORT, OR ACCEPTABLE GOVERNMENT-ISSUED PICTURE IDENTIFICATION CARD (For each person). Photocopy must be legible.
6. ASSOCIATE APPLICATION AND FEE \$50.00
(if applicable) Money order, Cashier's check, Agency's business check, or Cash.
7. COPY OF ASSOCIATE'S DRIVER'S LICENSE
(if applicable) Money order, Cashier's check, Agency's business check, or Cash.
8. CLASSIFIABLE FINGERPRINT CARD, FINGERPRINT AFFIDAVIT AND FEE \$22.00
(For each person) Money order, Cashier's check, Agency's business check, or Cash.
9. ONE 2" X 2" PASSPORT STYLE COLOR FACIAL PHOTOGRAPH
(For each person) Facial photographs must be in focus.

NOTE: IF ITEMS #1, #2, #3, AND #9 ARE MISSING OR INCOMPLETE, YOUR APPLICATION PACKET WILL BE RETURNED WITHOUT PROCESSING.

The applicant's fingerprints will be used to check the criminal history records of the FBI. The procedures for obtaining a change, correction, or updating of your criminal history record are set forth in Title 28, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Section 16.34.
